Bookmobile.

Our model of service and vehicles have been of interest to several outside agencies. We have had librarians from Manitoba, CA and Eau Claire visit to learn more about our program. We also have been contacted by the County's Waste & Renewables about our vehicles; they are planning a mobile interactive space for students.





Dream Bus.

The fall schedule is underway and busy! We are piloting service to the *Bridge-Lakepoint-Waunona* neighborhood in October. Through the end of the year, we will take the Bus to the BLW Community Center for 2 hours on Fridays. This service will intersect with the Center's community lunch and will target seniors and families with pre-school children. If successful, we will look to budget for this service in 2020 with Madison Public Library Foundation.

Friends report.

We have a Friends phone meeting scheduled for 10/2. We have identified a *book sale space* on the Bookmobile and will begin promotion as soon as we received signage. We also have planned a *mobile sale* the week of October 21.

Bluff View service.

We have been asked by the Prairie du Sac Public Library to provide service to the *Bluff View* neighborhood in 2020. This is a community about 12 miles north of our Roxbury stop. I am working on a draft contract for this service. The 1-hour stop would be added to our Saturday route.

iSchool Student.

We are happy to be hosting a field work student from the UW iSchool. *Abby Ryan*, also a Sequoya Branch Community Engagement Librarian, is spending her 120-hour practicum at DCLS. Her objectives include:
