The changes in the ordinances raise fees for revenue funded programs to insure that revenue covers the cost of the program.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Approximately 10% increase in fees for the Well and Septic program and a 17% increase in fees for the Licensed Establishment program. This revision also raises the County dog tax by \$5 per license to fund the contract with Dane County Humane Society. Corrects some references to WI administrative code.
