- ✓ Weekly presence at the Job Center
- ✓ Celebration of the 3rd anniversary of service to Owl Creek
- ✓ Increased staff diversity
- ✓ Launch of the Dream Bus in April 2019
- ✓ Staff attendance at Wisconsin Library Association program of "So You Want to Talk about Race?" by Ijeoma Oluo
- ✓ Planning county-wide project, funded by Beyond the Page, for library staff training and community programming centered around racial equity and social justice

The Library has made the following efforts towards **Sustainability**, including:

- ❖ Discarded library materials sent to Better World Books for world-wide reuse
- ❖ Improved gas mileage & reduced emissions on new Bookmobile
- ❖ Improved access to Bookmobile routes at Stoughton Road location
- Solar panels to offset carbon power
- ❖ Sharing undercarriage wash unit with Emergency Management
- Staff use of bus passes provided by County
- Provide Dream Bus stops to meet patrons where they are (schools, community centers, parks) to reduce need for travel
