<p>PFAS are a group of chemicals found in numerous consumer products, including fire-fighting foam. Studies have shown that exposure to two of these compounds, PFOA and PFOS, can lead to adverse health outcomes in humans. For 45 years, from 1970-2015, fire-fighting foam containing PFAS was used at the Truax Base, according to the WI National Guard. Testing revealed very high levels, 39,841 parts per trillion, in the shallow groundwater beneath Truax Air National Guard base. PFAS has been detected in the drinking water of Well 15, which is less than a mile from Truax Field and remains out of service indefinitely. Recent <a href="#">DNR testing</a> also revealed high levels of PFAS in Starkweather Creek. At this time, no federal funds have been allocated to further testing and remediation. By letter dated October 11, 2019, the WI DNR informed the Dane County Regional Airport that it is a responsible party for the PFAS contamination. Action is needed to respond to DNR direction and prevent the spread of contamination.</p>
