AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT OF 2019 BUDGET
TO ACCEPT FUNDS FROM CLEAN LAKES ALLIANCE

The Water Resource Engineering Division in the Land & Water Resources Department has been awarded a staffing grant from the Clean Lakes Alliance in the amount of \$10,000 to fund a LTE Erosion Control Specialist project position. The position would assist division staff in conducting erosion control inspection of construction sites.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Land & Water Resources Department, Water Resource Engineering Division is hereby authorized to accept \$10,000 from the Clean Lakes Alliance;

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that revenue account LWRWRED 80202 Clean Lakes Revenue be increased \$10,000 and expense account LWRWRED 10072 Limited Term Employees shall be increased by \$9,289 and that LWRWRED 10108 Social Security be increased by \$711.
