1. Journey Mental Health Update

Lynn Brady and Alan Zoellner gave an update on activities and events offered related to employee engagement. Colleen Clark Buss, Chief HR Officer, and Tanya Lettman-Shue talked about the avenues that employees have available to talk to management about workplace concerns. They talked about consumer socio-economic issues, demographics served, insurance obstacles, generational trends affecting employees, fundraising efforts, etc. Kuhn asked for a list of organizations in partnership with Journey Mental Health. They also mentioned the robust in house training programs that are offered for staff and how county, state and federal level changes prove difficult for staff.
