 - Commit to long-term affordability
 - Include units for 30 percent CMI HHs
 - Include supportive services by local providers
 - Offer generous tenant screening criteria
 - Provide access to jobs, schools, transportation, etc.
 - Consider sustainability, e.g. renewable energy

AHDF FUNDING


- Annual funding from county capital budget

- Funds typically comprise one piece of larger, more complex funding package (e.g. LIHTC, FHLB, TID/other local, etc.)


