Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

This Resolution would allow the Waste and Renewables Division to sell surplus equipment. The Waste and Renewables Division has a CNG Fueling Skid for which it has no purpose. The original purchase price was \$340,240.00.

Current Policy or Practice -

Pursuant to Dane County Ordinance 25.12(4), no property with an original cost to the County of more than \$200,000 shall be considered surplus until declared as such by the County Board.

Impact would allow Purchasing Manager and Waste and Renewables Division to sell this piece of equipment. Sale would provide funds to the Waste and Renewables fund. It would also reduce the annual maintenance and depreciation costs within the Waste and Renewables operating budget.
