3	AUTHORIZING THE RECLASSIFICATION OF A CHILD SUPPORT INVESTIGATOR POSITION TO A
4	LEAD CHILD SUPPORT INVESTIGATOR POSITION IN THE DANE COUNTY
5	CHILD SUPPORT AGENCY

7	The Office of the Corporation Counsel has requested that a vacant Position No. 2195 be
8	reclassified from a Child Support Investigator, G17 to a Lead Child Support Investigator, G19 in
9	its Child Support Agency ("CSA").
10	
11	The request is based upon the following. The CSA is continuing its push to modernize its practices,
12	and improve its performance. The new lead investigator position will be dedicated to monitoring
13	internal processes to help child support staff, and to ensure that the CSA workload continues to be
14	addressed in a timely manner. Moreover, the CSA currently has only one (1) lead investigator who
15	must monitor the workload of 23 investigators. The lead investigator's ability to effectively monitor
16	and assist with the workload of the investigators is compromised whenever an unforeseen issue or
17	new State mandated initiative requires the lead investigator's efforts. Having another lead

investigator will allow the CSA to split the number of investigators among the two leads and thereby

create additional capacity. Reclassifying position no. 2195 to a Lead Child Support Investigator will

result in the position being placed in Range 19 in EG 720 with a starting wage of \$26.80.
