In this program area, the existing vendor is the only vendor known at this time that possesses the unique and singular ability to meet the Department's requirements. This is the case due to two major factors:

1. Porchlight is the only provider of emergency overnight shelter for men over the age of 18 able to serve a sizable portion of the population experiencing homelessness in this target group. To staff's knowledge, no other agency is interested in providing this service that would also have the facilities/institutional capacity necessary to provide the service and would follow the Homeless Services Consortiums' written standards for shelter provision.

2. The provider has established and long-standing lease agreements with congregations in downtown Madison with which it partners to provide space for emergency overnight shelter operations.
