

GAPS FOR YOUTH

- Range of mental and behavioral health services
 - Especially for youth of color
 - Also especially for members of the LGBTQ community
- Services can be one on one, group, formal treatment or more informal supports/referrals

GAPS FOR ADULTS (One-time funding)

- Some major gaps are being addressed through other avenues:
 - Behavioral Health Resource Center, a.k.a “Universal Access Call Center”
 - System coordination, formalized partnerships for navigation
 - Behavioral Health Subcommittee of the Criminal Justice Subcommittee
 - Crisis, access for those recently released, jail diversion
- Other opportunities for the CJ Tubbs Fund include:
 1. Culturally and linguistically appropriate providers for the LatinX community, especially recent immigrants. Scholarships/other incentives for training/education of providers or those looking to become providers.
 2. Encouraging more development in the provider community for professionals of color; credentialing, organizational development, incentives to hire and retain staff of color in existing organizations.
 3. Efforts to reduce stigma and raise awareness, especially targeted to connecting with communities of color. Potentially tied to launch of Behavioral Health Resource Center.
 4. Incentivizing peer support expansion if efforts can be sustained programmatically on an on-going basis.
 5. Potential start up for sober housing.
