WIS 19 Proposed Indian Lake Pedestrian Underpass

James presented the recent information from the WisDOT Project Manager for a pedestrian underpass for the Ice Age Trail connecting Indian Lake County Park property to the Halfway Prairie Wildlife Area property. WisDOT has been working with the Park Commission to provide a pedestrian underpass as 4(f) mitigation for the project impacts of the STH 19 Improvement Project. The State will cover the proposed costs for a basic underpass that would include a 96-inch diameter corrugated metal pipe with standard metal endwalls (estimated at \$68,000). Any additional upgrades the County would seek are the responsibilities of the County. The upgrade scenario (see file attached below), presented with graphics include:

- Alternative #1 96-Inch Metal Culvert with Concrete Endwalls, \$10,000
- Alternative #2 96-Inch Metal Culvert with Stamped & Stained Concrete Endwalls, \$20,000
- Alternative #3 8' Tall x 8' Wide Concrete Box with Concrete Endwalls, \$40,000
- Alternative #4 8' Tall x 8' Wide Concrete Box with Stamped & Stained Concrete Endwalls, \$50,000

James stated that if the Park Commission chose to move forward with an enhanced alternative such as the stamped endwalls that they should be matched to the limestone associated with the building foundations on the adjacent Halfway Prairie Property.
