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# Project Background and Goals

- Pretrial Justice Collaborative (PJC) goals:

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# Study Approach : Two tiers of research


Tier 1: Process and Descriptive Analysis (all 8 sites)	<ul> <li>What are the practices and policies around pretrial release conditions and intervention strategies? How is pretrial supervision implemented?</li> <li>What are court appearance rates for defendants assigned to various release conditions and interventions?</li> </ul>
Tier 2: Impact Studies with Rapid Cycle Feedback (4 sites)	<ul> <li>Is a particular pretrial supervision intervention more effective than a less restrictive intervention on court appearance, case outcomes, and new crime charges?</li> <li>Does a less burdensome intervention decrease defendants' court appearance?</li> </ul>



# Outcomes (Tier 1\*\*)

- Pretrial release conditions/bail setting
- Court appearance/failure to appear
- Bench warrants
- Case dispositions and time to case dispositions
- Re-arrests
- Pretrial supervision levels, contacts, compliance (Tier 2)
- Other?

\*\*Some of the above will also be outcomes in Tier 2 impact analyses

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### Data Elements We'll Request

Case or event level data:

- Defendant demographics and criminal history
- Risk assessment scores/information
- Arrest dates and charges
- Pretrial release conditions and bail setting
- Hearings and hearing outcome
- Bench warrants
- Court appearance and failure to appear
- Case outcomes/dispositions
- Pretrial services data: supervision levels, contact date and type, noncompliance, discharge dates and reasons, etc.

Data may originate from multiple sources (e.g. AOC, pretrial services)

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# Tier 1: Deliverables (February 2020-December 2020)

- Site-specific research report with results from Tier 1 data analysis:
  - System and process map
  - Release conditions
  - Trends in court appearance rates over recent timeframe
  - Court appearance and case outcomes for:
    - All cases
    - By release condition
    - o Charge class
    - o Defendant race/ethnicity, risk level, age
  - Pretrial services participation and outcomes
  - Other site-specific analysis
