THE GREEN INDUSTRY IN WISCONSIN

It is a \$1.06 billion dollar industry in Wisconsin

- Includes:
 - > \$377 million in Lawn & Garden Services
 - > \$298 million in Lawn & Garden Supplies (outdoor plants, etc.)
- \$218 million in Lawn & Garden Equipment
- > \$28 million in Repair/Rental of Lawn & Garden Equipment
- > \$137 million in Indoor Plants & Fresh Flowers
- This total spending represents the aggregate amount spent by all households in the state annually. (Source: ESRI and Bureau of Labor Statistics)
