ACCEPTANCE OF DONALD ROCK WAYSIDE FROM WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

In 1952, the Delma Donald Woodburn family donated approximately 2.58 acres including Donald Rock to the WI Dept. of Transportation to serve as a scenic wayside park. WI DOT proposes to transfer the 2.56 acres to the county to become part of Donald County Park. Donald County Park is adjacent to the property and WI DOT has historically allowed the County Parks staff and the Friends of Donald Park to manage the property as part of the park <u>Current Policy or Practice -</u>

Property transfers require County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

A condition of the transfer would that the property only be used for park purposes and remain in public ownership in perpetuity. WI DOT and the county have agreed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding regarding management of the property as parkland which shall include public access.
