## 2020 RES-062 RECOGNIZING MAY 17-23, 2020 AS EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES WEEK IN DANE COUNTY

**WHEREAS** the Dane County Emergency Medical Service (EMS) regional system provides coordinated, quality care to the residents of Dane County, and access to quality emergency care dramatically improves the survival and recovery rate of those who experience sudden illness or injury; and

**WHEREAS** during the COVID-19 global pandemic, EMS personnel have increased risk, and yet each of the providers continues to respond and provide exceptional care to the residents of Dane County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Dane County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes the week of May 17<sup>th</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup> as EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES WEEK in Dane County, as a tribute to the dedication and accomplishments of the Dane County Emergency Medical Services providers, including emergency physicians, emergency nurses, emergency medical technicians, paramedics, firefighters, educators, and administrators.
