Hicklin reviewed requirements of Dane County Shoreland Erosion Control Ordinance and the appeals process as set forth in Dane County Code of Ordinances.

Balousek discussed county staff's inspection process, determination of shoreland zone and the definition of land disturbance under county ordinance. Balousek stated two items are being appealed:

- 1. Was the action taken a land disturbance activity?
- 2. Is the property within the shoreland zone? (See attachment 2020 APP-001)

Thompson stated he did not believe the actions taken on the property were a land disturbance activity as trees were removed using a grinder attached to a bobcat. As the trees were removed, the material was immediately mulched back on the site and the only land disturbance was from the tracks of the bobcat due to wet conditions. Thompson said he was not disputing the area was within the shoreland zone. (See attachment 2020 PRES-009)

A motion was made by DOWNING, seconded by LEVIN, that the actions taken by Mr. Thompson did not constitute a land disturbance activity. The motion failed by the following vote: 3/5 (CHAWLA, RITT, GRAY, HATCHER, MCGINNITY no)

Noes: 5 - Chair CHAWLA, Supervisor RITT, Supervisor GRAY, Secretary HATCHER and Supervisor MCGINNITY

A motion was made by RITT, seconded by HATCHER, that if Mr. Thompson applies for the appropriate permit and pays fees as is required by Dane County Code of Ordinances the Land & Water Resources Department consider rescinding the citation issued to TMS Investements LLC. The motion carried by voice vote: 8/0
