Tessmann reported:

- The childcare grant is approximately half disseminated.
- Tenant Resource Center received their funds and is on target to launch the portal on Monday.
- The Department has focused on reconstitution including opening the ADRC and Job Center to walk-in customers. At the Job Center, plexiglass has been installed, traffic patterns rerouted, vast majority of staff will continue to work remotely, increased security, people will be required to wear masks, limit to 25% capacity. Sup Doyle added:
- Public Health data analysis should be finished tomorrow.
- Sup Stubbs offered to help make sure the TRC funds are dispersed in an inclusive manner.
- Men's Shelter Steering Committee will be meeting virtually City staff have been looking at sites.
