1. Land Information Office Budget 2020 - J. Mueller

John Mueller presented the Land Information Office proposed budget. Once again the department budget will use the Register of Deeds recorded document count of 80,000. Fly Dane 2020 will be GPR funded henceforth. The Planning & Development office staff support had been moved in the LIO 2019 budget and added to the Register of Deeds department budget. There are increases for the LTE wage increase, printer maintenance and telephone expense (ipad data plans). The Strategic Initiative Grant funds will be shown on two lines (project funding and carry over).

Fred lausly presented the planned projects for the office for 2020, in support of the budget.

The budget was unanimously approved by Frick/Violante.

2. Fly Dane 2020 - F. lausly

Fred lausly announced we have a contract for Fly Dane 2020 with Ayers & Associates. The cost approximates \$100,000 which includes county wide color 6-inch imagery. This, and all future, Fly Dane projects will be GPR funded, with no future borrowing expected. Through the WRock program, which partners with larger regional firms and utilities, there may be potential cost savings.
