- Purchased iPads, laptops, portable DVD players for youth
- PPE-Immediately secured masks, face shields, sanitizer, gowns, thermometers, etc.
- UW medical staff training and close collaboration
- COVID-19 test kits secured
- Court hearings, assessments, family, social worker, attorney visits via video

- Staff education and support
- Emergency food supply secured
- Increased gym time and other organized rec activities
- Increased phone calls for residents
- Updated policies and procedures
- Opened up an additional wing with more rooms in Detention
- Adjustments to HDP supervision
- ► Added a 4<sup>th</sup> HDP caseload
