JULY 28,2020

- ▶ Attempts to reduce detention population, no out-of-county youth/sanctions/rule violation DOC holds, information to law enforcement, strict screening protocols for JRC intakes- population as of 7/24/20 is 3 residents in Detention and 2 residents at Shelter Home.
- ▶ Discouraged and then ceased visits
- ▶ No outside groups/visitors
- ▶ Purchased iPads, laptops, portable DVD players for youth
- ▶ PPE-Immediately secured masks, face shields, sanitizer, gowns, thermometers, etc.
- ▶ UW medical staff training and close collaboration
- ▶ COVID-19 test kits secured
- ▶ Court hearings, assessments, family, social worker, attorney visits via video

- ▶ Staff education and support
 - ▶ Emergency food supply secured
 - ▶ Increased gym time and other organized rec activities
 - ▶ Increased phone calls for residents
 - ▶ Updated policies and procedures
 - ▶ Opened up an additional wing with more rooms in Detention
 - ▶ Adjustments to HDP supervision
 - ▶ Added a 4th HDP caseload
