New Incident Commander as of Monday

goal: to rotate this position more frequently.

Emergency Order #8 is in Effect

Among other requirements, the Order includes a mask requirement.



Face Coverings (Masks)

Key Differences in Dane County vs. State Order

Dane County Order

Face coverings required:

Indoors and in any enclosed building where other people, except for members of the person's own household or living unit, could be or are present.

In line to enter any indoor space.

State Order (8/2)

Face coverings required in any other confined space open to the public where individuals congregate, including but not limited to outdoor bars, outdoor restaurants, and outdoor park structures.

Further defines what a face covering is and is not (i.e., does not allow face shields, mesh masks, masks with holes or openings, or masks with vents).

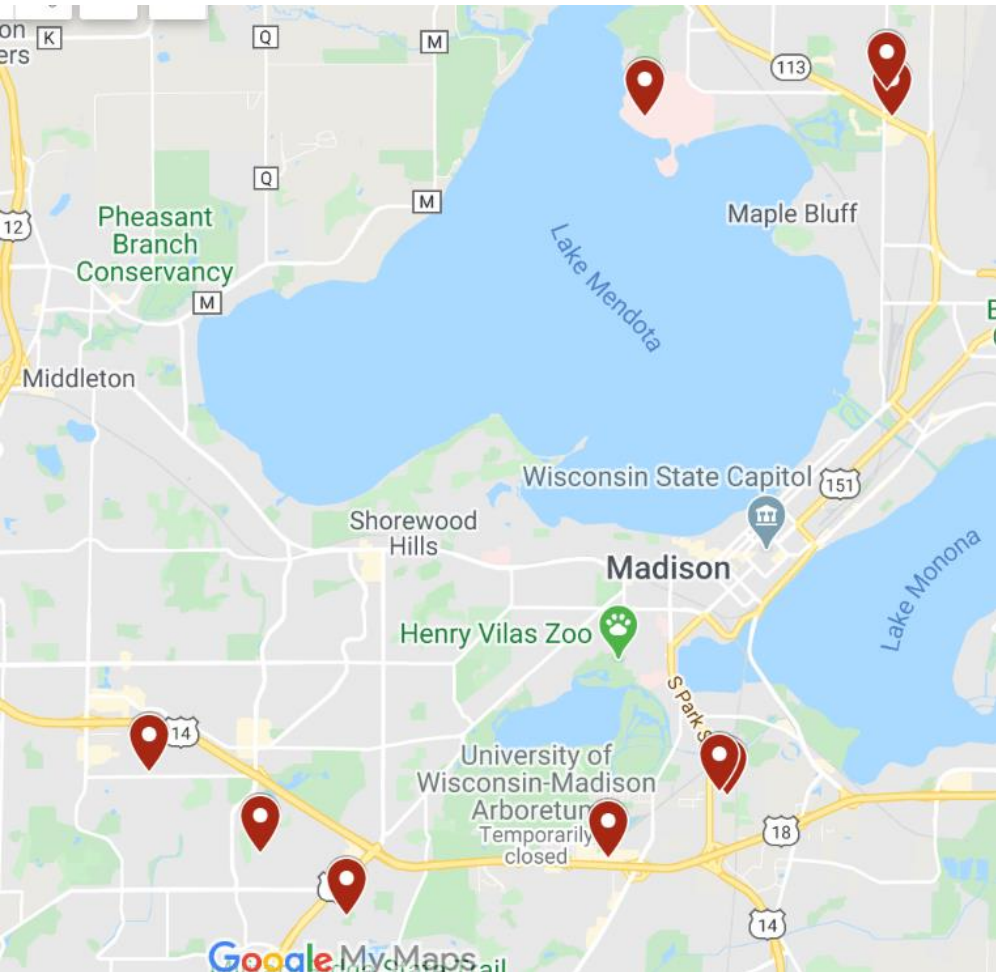
Testing

Yesterday the 100,000th sample was collected at Alliant Energy Center.

Since June 27, we have implemented 9 pop-up test sites and have tested 3,410 people at these sites.

Anticipate operating on Monday,
Wednesdays, and Fridays

Extended hours at least 1 day per
week

Contact Tracing

61 people doing contact tracing work, 38 staff supporting this work

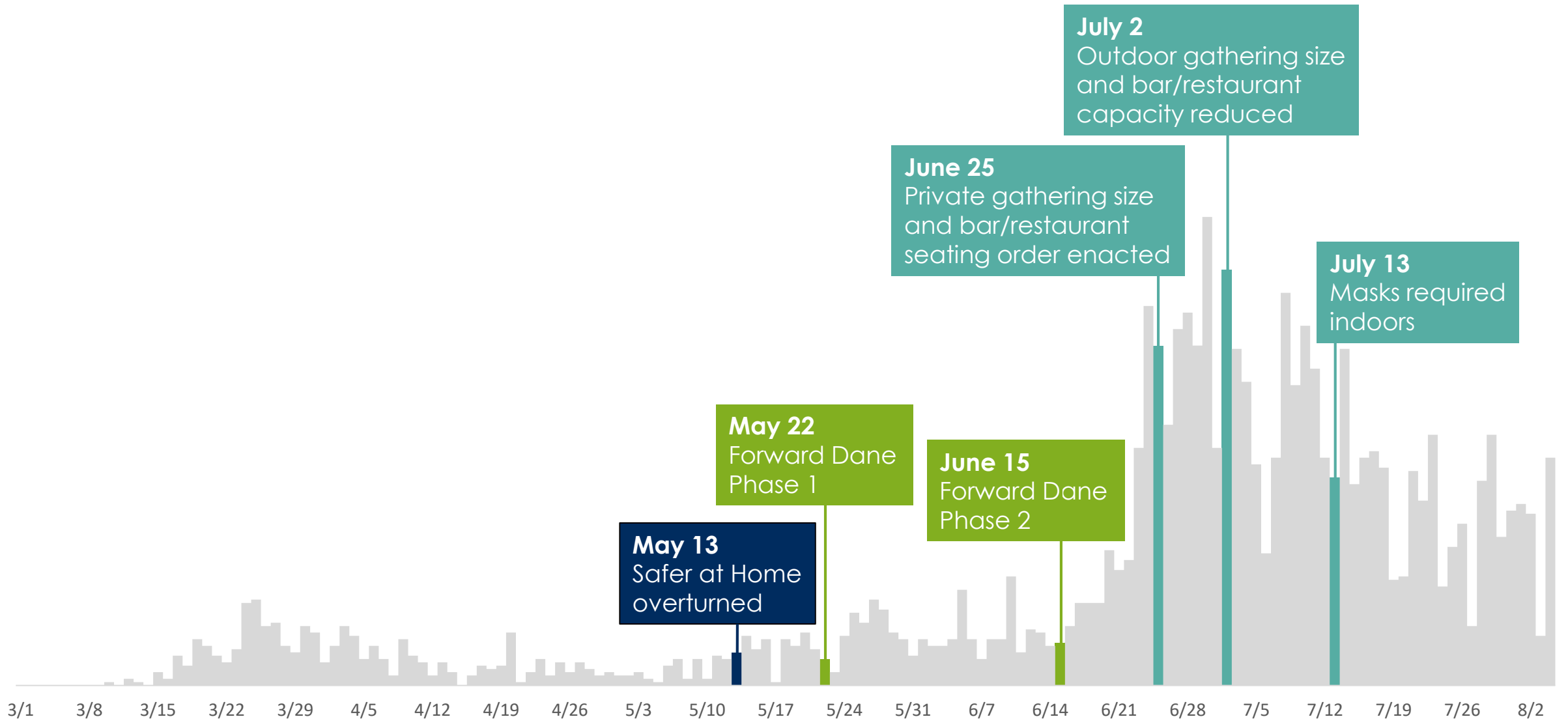
28 contact tracers starting over the next 4 weeks

64% of cases contacted within 48 hours of being tested

72% of cases were interviewed within 24 hours of receiving their test result.
