Commissioners reviewed and discussed each of the written public comments and suggestions that were received (2020 ACT-088 Public Comment on LWC 2021 Budget Recs.pdf).

- Commissioners had questions on the location and placement of signs related to comments submitted by Capital Water Trails LTD and signs marking water feature crossings on County highways.
- The Friends of Lake Wingra's comments for an aquatic plant harvester for Lake Wingra were also discussed. Reimer provided information on how harvesting plans are developed in conjunction with WDNR. Commissioners highlighted the existing LWC 2021 Budget Recommendation requesting two additional harvesters. Harvesters are not limited in where they can be used within the Yahara River and Yahara Chain of Lakes since they are hydrologically connected. Reimer indicated that harvesting is prioritized in areas where aguatic plant growth is restricting the flow of water in order to help mitigate flooding risk.
- · Commissioners discussed comments received by the Friends of Lake Wingra regarding funding for rain gardens in low-income and POC communities. Commissioners identified existing programs including a 50/50 cost share program through the City of Madison and the Dane County - Plant Dane program. Commissioners asked for a report on the Plant Dane program at its next scheduled meeting.
- · Comments received by the Monona Bay Neighborhood Association were in support of many existing LWC 2020 Budget Recommendations. ERICKSON asked for an update on the pumping study for the Yahara Lakes watershed/chain. Reimer stated that priority has been focused on the Yahara River Sediment Removal Project.

Caryl Terrell provided public comment in support of the LWC 2021 Budget Recommendations.

A motion was made by UPDIKE, seconded by McCARVILLE, to approve the final LWC 2021 Budget Recommendations (attached as LWC 2021 Budget Recommendations Final_Approved_8-19-20). The motion carried by a voice vote:
