ACCEPTING COVID RELIEF FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FOR PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT, TESTING SUPPLIES AND TECHNOLOGY FOR RESIDENT USE DCDHS – BPHCC DIVISION

A direct distribution of Federal CARES Act funding has been transferred from the US
Department of Health and Human Services to the Badger Prairie Healthcare Center
(BPHCC) to be used for COVID-19 infection control, testing and personal protective
equipment (PPE). This resolution increases Dane County budget authority for the
Badger Prairie Healthcare Center in order to receive federal relief funding and to execute
related expenditures.

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This distribution is specifically to reimburse nursing homes for infection control. This includes administering COVID-19 tests to both residents and staff; reporting results to local, state and federal governments; infection control expenses as needed including consultations with subject matter experts and additional PPE; and providing additional services to residents, such as technology for residents to connect with their families.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that revenue and expenditure budget authority
 for the DCDHS – BPHCC Division be increased by \$184,000, and that expenditures are
 authorized for all COVID-19 testing requirements, PPE and other related infection
 control safety measures at the facility.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following revenue and expenditure accounts be
 adjusted in the amounts presented below:
