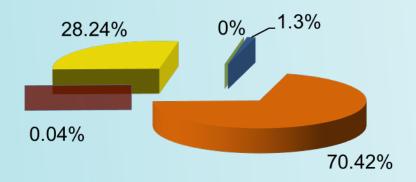

Projected Revenue to Expenses

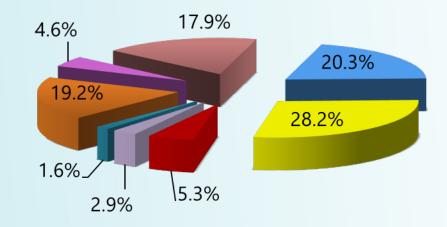


2021 Operating Revenues

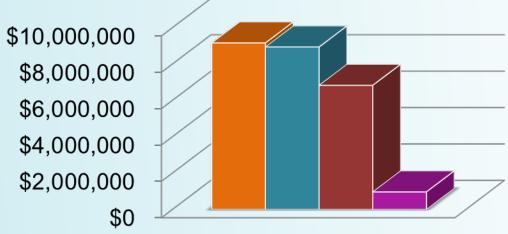
