2	AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR COVID-19
3	CONTACT TRACING

5	A major strategy for containment of COVID-19 is identifying the cases and contacts of of
6	persons who test positive for the virus. Public Health for Madison and Dane County
7	(PHMDC) has been using existing staff and limited term employees for this effort to
8	date. To supplement these efforts until the end of 2020, PHMDC has negotiated a
9	contract with Maxim, Inc. to provide contract tracing services. Supplementing this key
10	element of the COVID response via contract will allow for PHMDC resources to be
11	allocated more efficiently across the COVID response structure and create surge
12	capacity as the pandemic expands and contracts over time. The cost of the contract
13	would be paid from the County's Coronavirus Relief allocation. The estimated cost of
14	the contract is \$1.1 million.
15	
16	THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the County Board approves the contract with
17	Maxim, Inc. in an amount of approximately \$1,100,000, that the County Executive and
18	County Clerk are authorized to execute the contract and the Controller's Office is
19	authorized to issue payments under the contract; and

21	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that account ADMADM 20025 COVID-19 Expenses be
22	increased by \$1,100,000 and that revenue account ADMADM 80002 CARES ACT
23	Revenue be increased by \$1,100,000
