WHEREAS, COUNTY, whose address is c/o Deputy Public Works Director, 1919 Alliant Energy Center Way, Madison, WI 53713, desires to have CONTRACTOR furnish <u>Courthouse</u> <u>HVAC Controls Replacement</u> ("the Project"); and

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR, whose address is <u>3201 West Canal St, Milwaukee, WI 53208</u> __________ is able and willing to construct the Project,


