### **A Partnership**

This study: a partnership among Dane County, Arnold Ventures, and the A2J Lab

- Dane County
  - Implementation of PSA (guidance from Marie VanNostrand, Luminosity team)
  - Development, adherence to study protocol
  - Compilation of data
- Arnold Ventures
  - Development of PSA
  - Funding of study
- A2J Lab
  - Development of study protocol
  - Analysis of data received from Dane County

### The Setting: Pretrial Release

Dane County Commissioner decision to detain or release (if so, then decide conditions) person arrested pending case disposition

- For person arrested, decision likely affects
  - Socioeconomic wellbeing
  - Case disposition
- For Dane County, decision likely affects
  - Community safety
  - Community social fabric
  - Administration of criminal justice
  - Public fisc

### The Setting: Pretrial Release

Risk inherent in any pretrial release system

- High costs to incarcerating all persons arrested before disposition
- High costs to incarcerating no persons arrested before disposition
- Decision to release some but not all requires balance of factors
  - Risk of new (violent) criminal activity
  - Racial disparities in predisposition incarceration
  - Failure to appear
  - Social, economic, fiscal costs of incarceration

# Public Safety Assessment ("PSA")

Information for the Commissioner to consider (not binding)

- 1-6 scale for failure to appear ("FTA")
- 1-6 scale for new criminal activity ("NCA")
- Flag for elevated risk of new violent criminal activity ("NVCA")

### Public Safety Assessment ("PSA")

#### Factors considered


- Age at current arrest
- Current offense violent
- 3. Pending charge at time of offense
- 4. Prior misdemeanor conviction
- Prior felony conviction
- 6. Prior violent conviction
- Prior FTA in past two years
- 8. Prior FTA older than two years
- Prior sentence to incarceration

### Decision Making Framework ("DMF")

Information for the Commissioner to consider (not binding)

- Combines information
  - PSA scores
  - Dane County values and policies
  - Wisconsin law
  - Dane County resources
- Produces recommendation regarding
  - Cash versus signature bond, amount if cash
  - Level of conditions


Result is a "PSA-DMF System" recommendation

#### How would we know?


- Previous studies suggest
  - PSA is "valid": higher scores correlated with increased incidence of FTA, N(V)CA for those released
  - Introduction of PSA coincides with reduction in crime, no increases (sometimes decreases) in FTA, N(V)CA
- But
  - Judges may figure out elevated risk on their own
  - Coincidence of PSA introduction could be other measures adopted at same time
- Need rigorous evidence

#### Primary outcomes (this report)

- FTA
- NCA
- NVCA
- Number of days of predisposition incarceration
- Measures of racial fairness

- Conviction & sentence
- Post disposition NCA, NVCA, incarceration

Study timeline

- 2016-2017: Discussions, training on PSA/DMF system
- April-May, 2017: PSA/DMF system implemented
  - Other reforms implemented almost simultaneously
  - Makes before/after study problematic, thus need for RCT
- May-June, 2017: Start of study
- Early 2019: Agreement to extend RCT to end of 2019
- December 31, 2019: close of study period
- December 31, 2021: close of follow-up data period

#### This Interim Report: Overall results

- Strong implementation of the PSA-DMF System
- Strong commitment to predisposition justice, a learning criminal justice system
- Not enough information to draw firm conclusions
  - Have: 12 months of cases, 12-month follow-up
  - Plan: 30 months of cases, 24-month follow-up
- What we see so far
  - Mild effect on Commissioner decisions, in expected direction
  - No effect on FTA, NCA, NVCA, # days of incarceration, racial fairness measures
  - Unexpected: reduction in variation of bond decisions
