ARTICLE 2.Sections 41.115(1) and (2) are amended to read as follows: 41.115 USER FEE SCHEDULE. (1) The standard fees for deposit of allowable solid wastes, other than tires and asphalt shingles, at Landfill No. 2 (Rodefeld site) or Construction and Demolition Recycling Facility shall be assessed according to the following schedule, plus all applicable State imposed fees (as listed on the ordinance amendment) and under (2) and (a)

## Impact of Adopting Proposal -

This amendment raises the fees for the disposal of solid waste and the deposit of construction and demolition waste to reflect market conditions and County costs to recycle and landfill these materials. This amendment also increases the minimum volume of waste a customer must bring to the facility to be considered a high volume user
