After that point and until the end of the pandemic, use online instruction as the default

modality, allowing departments to offer courses in-person only when pedagogically

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necessary. Design instructional programs around offering the highest-quality education at the lowest risk for students, workers, and community members.

 Make accessibility the default for educational delivery, providing equitable access to education for students with disabilities and/or chronic illness through universal accessible design that does not require medical documentation or an extensive application process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors urges UW-Madison Chancellor Rebecca Blank to require students test negative for Covid-19 before closing the residence halls and encouraging students to return to their homes for the safety of the greater Dane County community during the COVID-19 pandemic, with an exception for international students or students facing homelessness or an unsafe home life, who should be allowed to stay.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in light of statewide surges in COVID-19 particularly in cities with University of Wisconsin campuses, the Dane County Board of Supervisors urges Interim UW System President Tommy G. Thompson and the Wisconsin Board of Regents to consider directing other Wisconsin campuses to conduct all coursework virtually.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to UW-Madison Chancellor Rebecca Blank, UW System President Tommy G. Thompson, members of the Wisconsin Board of Regents, and Governor Tony Evers.
