County Ordinance Requirements

- S. 15.47 (4)(b), Dane County Code:

(b) The mapping process shall include opportunities for the public to submit map proposals for consideration.

Web-Based Mapping Software for Public Use

- Needs to be easy to use
- Allow for individual submittals of maps for Commission review
- Needs to provide census demographic data at block level
- Will have to be compatible and convertible to:
 - *County geographic information system software, and*
 - *Wisconsin Legislative Technical Board software for reporting local districts to the State of Wisconsin*
- Available in fall of 2020 for trial run before the “real thing” in Spring of 2021.

DistrictBuilder Software

- Used successfully in Philadelphia, Minneapolis and several other communities
- Finalizing contract with Dane County and Azavea, Inc. (DistrictBuilder software company)
