On August 26, 2020, chemical agents were deployed by the Sheriff'sOffice against persons exercising their first amendment rights to protest police brutality against Black people. Chemical agents are intended to inflict pain, can cause long term and permanent damage, and make a victim more vulnerable to respiratory illness, including COVID-19. Chemical agents are banned in war by international law, but allowed for domestic law enforcement's use in "riot control". The historic uprising in defense of Black lives has shed new light on the harm caused by the domestic use of crowd control weapons, particularly during the coronavirus pandemic.  This amendment requests the participation of the Dane County Sheriff's Office in the completion of a City of Madison Police Department study of the use of chemical munitions and report to the County Board early in the year. The Madison Police Department study is scheduled to be submitted to the Common Council by January 6, 2021.
