Public Health Madison and Dane County (PHMDC) has been working with Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. to support COVID-19 emergency response efforts to supplement staffing levels in the areas of contact tracing, testing, and vaccination since July 2020. In 2020 the contract for these services has been held between the Dane County Department of Administration and Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. and paid for through the County COVID Relief Fund allocation. Due to the ending of that funding stream and the Dane County contract expiring on February 1, 2021, PHMDC proposes entering into a purchase of service contract with Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. to continue these services funded through the Public Health fund balance, which represents grants recieved in 2020. A resoution to transfer the adequate fund balance amount to support this contract will be forthcoming.

The intent of this contract is to have the existing, trained contracted staff continue in their roles. PHMDC has dedicated significant time and effort in training the contracted staff and they are functioning as key members of the PHMDC COVID response team. Their continued participation in the areas of contact tracing, testing, and vaccination is critical to our continued success in the fight against COVID.
