AWARDING A CONTRACT TO TENANT RESOURCE CENTER, INC. FOR PANDEMIC RESPONSE EVICTION PREVENTION AND HOUSING STABILITY SERVICES DCDHS - HAA DIVISION

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

As the COVID-19 pandemic continues, the related crisis of the nation's economic downturn has created record unemployment and housing instability. On December 27th, 2020, President Trump signed the \$900 billion COVID-19 relief bill authorizing additional funding to respond to the pandemic across multiple areas of need. The act includes \$25 billion in funding for rental assistance, with Dane County anticipated to receive more than \$8.5 million of that amount to support local efforts to prevent evictions and provide housing stability.

Dane County Department of Human Services (DCDHS) Housing Access and Affordability (HAA) seeks to award a contract to the Tenant Resource Center (TRC) to administer a \$8,564,699 eviction prevention fund. Direct assistance for tenants in 2021 would continue to come wrapped in housing counseling, education for the landlord on federal mortgage protections, case management, outreach, and mediation services provided by TRC.

Current Policy or Practice -

Budget changes require County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Per the federal government, funding may be used to pay past rental and utility arrears and future rent and utility costs once any arrears have been cleared. To help ease the burden on renters, landlords or owners may apply on behalf of tenants meeting the eligibility requirements.
