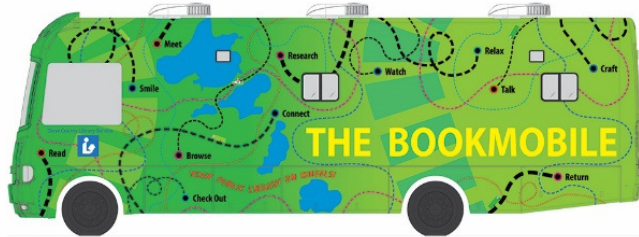




Bookmobile.
