Subcommittee Quarterly Report

<b>Subcommittee Name</b>	Criminal Justice Council (CJC)-Behavioral Health (BH) Subcommittee
<b>Quarter/Year</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> /2021
<b>What were the subcommittee's primary goals and objectives for the past quarter?</b>	The CJC BH Subcommittee focused on Intercept 2 (Initial Detention/Initial Court Hearings) of the Sequential Intercept Model (SIM) during the first quarter of 2021. The subcommittee set out to learn more about the recommendations at Intercept 2 as identified in the SIM report and to understand practices/policies implemented throughout Dane County at the intersection of initial detention/initial court hearings and behavioral health. The subcommittee also aimed to identify priorities at Intercept 2.
<b>What milestones and steps did the subcommittee accomplish towards these objectives?</b>	The CJC BH Subcommittee reviewed the recommendations as outlined in the SIM report for Intercept 2 and heard from subject matter experts throughout the quarter. Subcommittee members learned about the booking process, the Pretrial Services program, and the criminal justice diversion collaboration between the Madison Police Department, the District Attorney's Office, and the Dane County Sheriff's Office. Subcommittee members also heard from members of the public regarding their thoughts on Intercept 2. In March, subcommittee members voted on priorities they would like to further explore and research in the coming months.
<b>What are the subcommittee's primary goals and objectives for the upcoming quarter? What actions and initiatives are underway?</b>	The CJC BH Subcommittee will continue to discuss, research, and finalize the priorities at Intercept 2 during the second quarter of 2021. The CJC BH Subcommittee will also continue to receive updates on the crisis restoration and triage and restoration center Request For Proposal (RFP). The RFP was issued on February 16 and closed on March 30 <sup>th</sup> . The CJC BH Subcommittee will provide oversight and input into the planning process as needed.
<b>What is the timeline for these objectives, actions, and initiatives?</b>	The CJC BH Subcommittee would like to have the priorities for Intercept 2 finalized by July/August.
<b>Any additional comments</b>	Throughout the first quarter, the CJC BH Subcommittee received updates on the implementation and operation of the Behavioral Health Resource Center (BHRC).
