1 2021 RES-081 2 3 AUTHORIZING RECLASSIFICATION OF A PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE POSITION TO A SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH COORDINATOR IN PUBLIC HEALTH-MADISON 4 5 AND DANE COUNTY 6 7 Public Health Madison & Dane County (PHMDC) has a vacant Public Health Nurse Position 8 (#2698) which we request to be reclassified to a Sexual and Reproductive Health Coordinator 9 position (N18A). A Public Health Supervisor in the Community Health Division will supervise this 10 position. This position is currently vacant and the Department of Administration – Employee Relations has recommended approval of this request. 11 After a thorough assessment of the recently resigned Public Health Nurse position and the shift 12 of the STI/HIV Coordinator (N18A) to the Communicable Disease Coordinator (N18A) to support 13 on-going COVID-19 response work and other communicable disease programming, we have 14 determined that the support needed in the department is aligned with the complexity and level of 15 16 responsibility associated with a Sexual and Reproductive Health Coordinator (N18A). The SRH 17 Coordinator is a lead worker position who will focus on grant writing, scheduling clinics and staff, 18 writing and updating protocols pertaining to HIV testing, Hepatitis C testing and STI follow-up 19 and surveillance, as well updating orders under our medical director. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors does 20 hereby support and authorize reclassification of the Public Health Nurse Position (#2698) in 21 22 Public Health Madison & Dane County to a Sexual and Reproductive Health Coordinator 23 (N18A), commensurate with the Department's request and approval of the Department of 24 Administration – Employee Relations Division. 25 26

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that position #2698, which has been vacant for more than six months, is authorized to be filled pursuant to Dane County Ordinance 29.52(15), which requires the Personnel and Finance Committee to approve filling positions that are vacant for more than
