AUTHORIZING RECLASSIFICATION OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE #2698 TO SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH COORDINATOR IN PUBLIC HEALTH MADISON & DANE COUNTY

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

Public Health of Madison and Dane County (PHMDC) has requested to reclassify position #2698. This position is currently vacant and classified as a Public Health Nurse (N18). Due to changes in staffing needs related to communicatable disease management, position #2698 has been reassigned duties that align with the Sexual and Reproductive Health Coordinator (N18A) classification.

Current Policy or Practice -

Reclassifying and combining positions of different classifications requires approval of the County Board.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Position #2698 will provide continued leadership for the SRH team and be responsible for assisting grant writing, scheduling clinics and staff, writing and updating protocols pertaining to HIV testing, Hepatitis C testing and STI follow-up and surveillance, as well updating orders under our medical director.
