In addition to the written report, DCDHS Director Shawn Tessmann reported Tenant Resource Center is close to clearing its backlog of eviction prevention applications ahead of the federal eviction moratorium expiring on June 30th. DCDHS staff with expertise in providing housing assistance were temporarily reassigned to assist TRC.

Recovery Innovations, a national practice and thought leader regarding crisis space, has been hired to assess and develop a plan to establish Dane County's Mental Health Triage and Restoration Center. Recovery Innovation provides direct service in six states, has been involved with writing federal best-practices toolkits, and is considered a consultant and subject matter expert.

Chair Doyle and Public Protection and Judiciary Committee Chair Maureen McCarville have agreed to hold a joint meeting on August 5th. The primary purposes of the joint meeting are to establish ways to solicit feedback from stakeholders and policymakers regarding the implementation of the Mental Health Triage and Restoration Center and how to improve the mental health court system.

2. Board and Committee Updates

Wegleitner, a member of the City of Madison Education Committee, reported the body recently voted to communicate its desire to have the City, the County, and the Madison Metropolitan School District communicate and collaborate regarding ways to use American Rescue Plan Act dollars and other funding sources to address five priorities in supporting MMSD families: Youth Employment, Youth and Family Homelessness, Mental Heath, Transportation, and Digital Access. Wegleitner stated there may be opportunities for Dane County staff to assist in the initiative and that she would welcome input about how to facilitate the collaboration.
