Using the information gathered from the census, county and local governments must draw new county supervisory and aldermanic districts. District lines determine which communities vote for which representatives in county or local elections. **The process of redrawing these lines is called redistricting.**

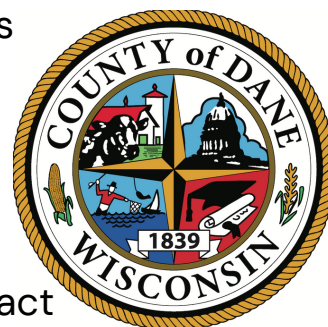


WHAT IS REPRESENTABLE?
