ACCEPTING COVID 19 VACCINE ACCESS FOR OLDER ADULTS GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES DCDHS – ACS DIVISION

7 The Wisconsin Department of Health Services has made federal funding available to expand 8 access to COVID-19 vaccinations via the Aging Network. In Dane County, the Area Agency on 9 Aging (AAA) is responsible for coordinating services to the population of older adults.

11 Earlier this year, the AAA collaborated with one of its focal points, NewBridge in Madison, and 12 the department's transportation team to provide nearly 600 rides for older adults to and from 13 vaccination appointments for older adults who had no other means of getting to those 14 appointments. This is one of the efforts that has contributed to Dane County's high partial 15 vaccination rate of residents who are 65 and older. This rate was 95.2% as of July 27, 2021, as 16 reported by the Public Health Department of Madison and Dane County.

18 Other allowable activities under this funding must directly support opportunities to vaccinate 19 eligible older adults, their caregivers, aging network staff and volunteers against COVID-19. The 20 goal of this funding is to support vaccination of as many people as possible. These funds are 21 available through September 30, 2022.
