1. Capital Springs Recreation Area Update

Chris James gave an overview of the Waucheeta Trail neighborhood meeting on Monday, July 26, 2021. Chris James, Joleen Stinson and DNR Representatives met on-site with the neighbors to discuss the planned trail connection project and other park improvement projects identified in the 2010 Capital Springs Recreation Area master plan. Some of the neighbors expressed safety concerns for bicyclists on the neighborhood road network related to increasing traffic amounts and vehicle speeds. Since the meeting, Chris James contacted several Dane County transportation planners. He shared the Madison Area Transportation Planning Board (MPO) road network suitability report map of this neighborhood. This map and report is based on traffic counts from 2017. The neighborhood street network is very suitable for an on-road bicycle trail. Chris James will schedule a follow-up neighborhood meeting this fall in coordination with the Town of Dunn and DNR to present this information to the residents.
