



On June 2, it was **12** and today it's **103.3**.




The rate for unvaccinated people is

as the rate for fully vaccinated people.


83.7% of our 12+ population has at least one dose of vaccine.




Hospitalizations




Testing in Dane County




Current Testing Volume & Capacity

Current Testing Volume 2,300 tests/day

Current Testing Capacity 3,000-3,500 tests/day

County-wide, testing is available over 100 hours/week, including nights and weekends
