- History:
 - Officially open in 1911. Land Grant received by the Vilas Family with the stipulation that no admission be charged
 - 1937 City of Madison assumes ownership
 - 1983 Ownership of Zoo is transferred from the City of Madison to Dane County

Mission: The Henry Vilas Zoo is dedicated to exceptional animal care and conserving wildlife through local engagement and global partnerships.

Vision: Locally loved community treasure, globally recognized conservation leader; forever accessible.



Measuring Social Media Impact



- So far this year, our Facebook page has reached over 3.6 million individual accounts (up 11.4%)
- We have 95,300 Facebook followers (up 4,000 people so far this year) and 23,100 Instagram followers (up 6,000 people so far this year)
