The commission reviewed maps submitted to date (see attachment "Maps_2021_09_14.pdf").

By general consensus, the Commission directed staff to provide further analysis of all submitted maps with a population range within 5% over or above the target population.

Brian Standing reported that county staff would meet with City of Madison staff working on the City's redistricting efforts. The purpose of the meeting is to coordinate and make sure city and county efforts are compatible.

The next meeting of the Dane County Redistricting Commission will take place on Thursday, September 23, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. on Zoom. The major topic will be a public hearing on proposed supervisory district maps. By general consensus, the Commission agreed to take registrants in the order that they register, and to limit speakers to 4 minutes apiece. Questions from Commissioners and responses from speakers will not count against speakers' time. Commissioners will discuss and deliberate on proposed maps after the public hearing is closed.
