Presenter: Carrie Springer, Dane County Legislative Lobbyist

Tentative federal Infrastructure bill which will provide additional funding of 65 billion dollars to broadband expansion. 42.5 billion provided to states through the National Telecommunication Information Administration (NTIA). Structure to this funding will be created within six months. 14 billion dollars allocated for permanent subsidies. 1 billion dollars provided to middle mile network also included in the Federal Infrastructure bill with application directly through NTIA.

Dane County currently benefiting from funds released from FCC through the RDOF expansion. Charter Communications and LTD Broadband currently expanding broadband within Dane County using this RDOF funding. Funding also included to update FCC maps. Discussion of contacting ISPs to gather the data they used to apply for this funding.

Discussion of other potential sources of information including John Hallick from the Town of Vermont broadband expansion, local schools, and families who participated in remote learning over the last year.

Rules and guidance for each grant depends of the source of the funds. State funding for broadband expansion passed earlier this year. McCallum discussed setting up a general plans for grants before they become available. McCallum also discussed requirements, information that needs to be included for grant application, and the evaluation of the grant applications.

State grants requirements are set by Wisconsin statute §196.5.4.

Kenney reviewed the Emergency Broadband Benefit program and American Rescue Plan Act funding, and federal infrastructure bill.
