In accordance with Section 85.21 of Wisconsin Statutes, the public is invited to make comment on the County Elderly and Disabled Transportation Assistance Program application. Dane County has budgeted State aid funds for transportation service to the elderly and disabled individuals. The proposed transportation projects are derived from the 2019 -2023 Coordinated Public Transit-Human Services Transportation Plan for Dane County.

A quorum of the Specialized Transportation Commission may be present but no action will take place.
