Priorities for the coming year

Discussion ensued around priorities of the CJC. Clark reviewed past expert recommendations and findings. Ozanne suggested giving the already existing Criminal Justice Group of Dane County specific areas to research and report to the CJC. Clark will follow up.

Esqueda lead a discussion around pretrial assessment, evidenced based practices and the use of drug monitoring for cases.

Clark discussed work of the Pre-trial Sub committee of the CJC around location of a race-neutral risk assessment tool.

Watson discussed potential of a risk assessment for revocation hearings out of custody. Clark will review research and report back to CJC.

Discussion ensued around re-entry, and the need to have Dept of Corrections representation. Clark notified CJC of the ordinance amendment which could add a representative of the Dept. of Corrections and a municipal judge as advisory members. Discussion ensues.

Parisi noted key to look for areas of duplication and inefficiencies in our criminal justice system, and then prioritize moving towards reform in those areas. Re-entry and Dept. of Corrections and Administrative Law Judges were discussed.
