*Sparkman - relative comparison numbers*

*Chance would like to see the percentage of people that are charged and have one contact with the system and don't come back. Question was asked, How long does it take to process the case?*

*Anhalt - need consistent definition of recidivism*

*Bauman - interested in timelines, particularly court timelines*

*Ozanne - The group needs to think about what the dashboard should look like, cautions trying to speed up the process, particularly the court process - need to build in time for the attorney's.*
