2. Implicit Bias Train the Trainer (Fall 2016)

Introduction of Noemi Reyes, Research Analyst

Bauman inquired about what the relationship of the CJC and RD committee should be.

Ozanne responded that he didn't get the sense that the CJC was opposed to the RD subcommittee giving ideas to them.

Data questions:

Discussion ensued regarding the data requests from the subcommittee. Sparkman inquired about the total number of African Americans in the county's correctional system, Anhalt responded that they are asked to self report.

Sparkman - relative comparison numbers

Chance would like to see the percentage of people that are charged and have one contact with the system and don't come back. Question was asked, How long does it take to process the case?

Anhalt - need consistent definition of recidivism

Bauman - interested in timelines, particularly court timelines

Ozanne - The group needs to think about what the dashboard should look like, cautions trying to speed up the process, particularly the court process - need to build in time for the attorney's.

If anyone has specific data requests, send them to Colleen in the next month - a work plan and markers of success will be developed over the next few months and presented to CJC
